

Red Flag Policy

In order to protect the rights of our patient's identity we are now required by the government to adhere to an identity theft prevention program. This requires every patient to show a photo ID at the time of each visit.

The purpose of the Red Flag Regulations Act of 2003 is to protect consumers from identity theft by requiring those creditors and financial institutions who collect this information to implement an identity theft program. From a medical practices standpoint, the Red Flag Regulations both protects the patients personal health information, which the practice is already required to protect under the Privacy and Security Regulations Act, and protects the patients from receiving inappropriate medical treatment based on another person's misuse of the individual patients identity.
